



## اختبار الفصل الثالث في مادة الانجليزية

Two years ago, Willow Lake was dirty and polluted. Nobody wanted to visit it. People came to the lake to throw away the rubbish. Then, a group of local people decided to clean it up. Forty eight volunteers helped. They worked in the evening and at weekends for eight months. When they cleaned the lake, they found four bicycles, ten shoes, three computers and three wheels from a car.

The group planted 75 trees and more than 500 flowers around the lake. "We have tried to make a beautiful environment for the local people", explains one volunteer. "By doing this, we have also created a habitat for wildlife". Now that Willow Lake is clean again, there are 24 ducks and 12 swans that have made it their home. There are a lot of fish, birds and other animals living there too.

The volunteers have put 20 wooden tables and chairs around the lake. Now local people can walk around the lake and have a picnic. "There are also a lot of bins", explains another volunteer, so please, don't throw your rubbish in the lake as before. "It's fantastic", says one local resident. "They have changed the lake completely". "I come and enjoy it every day".
