The text:

African forest elephant is an herbivorous mammal, and known scientifically as: 'Loxodonta cyclotis'. It lives in the dense rainforests of west and central Africa. It has got a grey skin, but differ in the size and colour of their tusks and in the shape and size of their ears and skulls. Males reach a shoulder height of 2.4 and 3 m tall and weigh between 4,000 and 7,000 kg, but females are about 1.8 and 2.4 m tall and weigh 2,000 and 4,000 kg. This elephant can run up to 40 km/hour. The female can give birth to 1 or 2 calves (babies) every 22 months. The African forest elephant eats leaves, grasses, seeds, fruit, and tree bark. These elephants live up to 65 years. They live in family groups of up to 20 individuals. There are less than 415.000 African forest elephants now. They are in danger of extinction because of habitat loss and habitat destruction due to change of forests for agriculture, livestock farming, and human's desire for building new houses.
