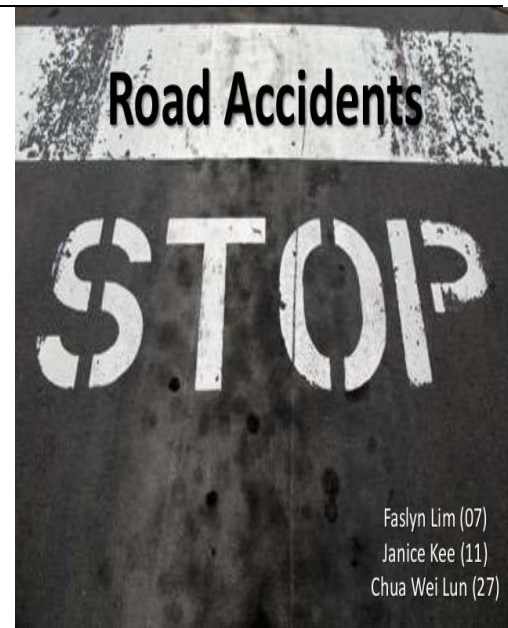
SIX PEOPLE KILLED IN ROAD ACCIDENT

Newsflash – Six people have been killed in a pile-up on the motorway1, this afternoon. Seventeen other people have been hurt. Six lorries and seventeen cars are involved in the crash.

The accident occurred shortly after 4:00 p.m. when a lorry was hit by another one which was overtaking it. The two lorries blocked the way, and they were hit then by several other cars. The cars and lorries caught fire. Some of the people were injured when they tried to escape from the fire. The motorway hasn't been cleared yet and the traffic is still being held up.

Ambulances and the fire brigades have been called from neighbouring towns and are converging to the site of the accident.
